Volunteer Opportunities:

- **Freedom Ambassadors** - Play a key role at community events, assisting with answering questions, handing out materials, running the information table, and speaking informally in their circles of influence in civic organizations, schools, churches and the workplace.
- **Freedom Assistants** - Administer staff large-scale projects that require printing, sorting, folding, stuffing envelopes, preparing mailings and other administrative tasks.
- **Freedom Movers** - Assist in relocating mentees' personal belongings to their new homes.
- **Freedom Outreach** - Assist with the collection, sorting, packing and distribution of backpacks, holiday bags and outreach resources as part of our prevention strategy for at-risk youth.

- **Freedom Educators** - Teach life skills training classes and work directly with mentees to instruct on various skills, including organization, housecleaning, cooking and other identified skills gaps.
- **Freedom Fundraisers** - Plan and execute events on behalf of The Underground for fundraising purposes.
- **Freedom Prayer Warriors** - Establish a team of prayer warriors who meet regularly (either in person or online) to pray for The Underground NE.
